Rules that ARE written

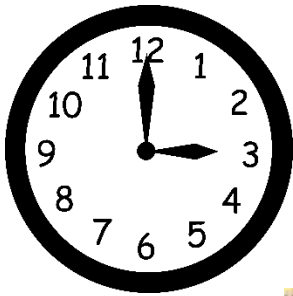
In society (us getting along with the rest of us),
what are some **RULES** that are written down?



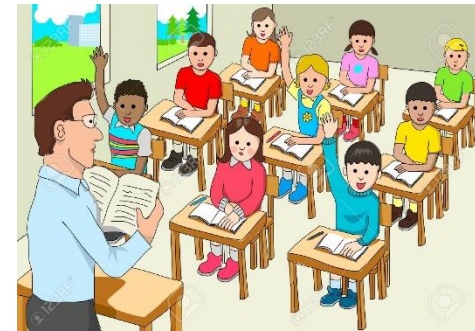
Speeding
