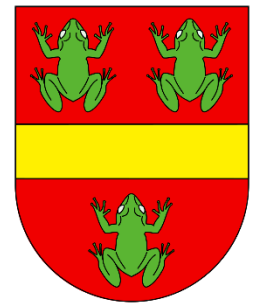

Coat of Arms/Family Crest



- **In the Middle Ages, individuals were identified by their Coat of Arms.**
- **As they were used on the battlefield to identify a person's friends and foes, they were often in the shape of a shield.**
- **The symbols used on coats of arms were chosen carefully to represent an individual or an entire family.**
- **The study of the symbols, colors and patterns used in Coats of Arms is known as heraldry.**
- **These Coats of Arms became Family Crests today.**
