Demonstrate what you have learned from your book by doing one of the following projects. These projects should be based on books you have NOT read before (200+ pages). See the book list on the back of this page for titles that cannot be used for these projects. You will do a different project each quarter.

Writing Projects <i>These projects should fill up at least one page, regular 12-font, double-spaced.</i>	Artistic Projects <i>These projects should be colorful and look professional. The ones on paper should cover the entire page.</i>	Technology Projects <i>Email these to your teacher.</i>	Performance Projects <i>Record these and email them to your teacher.</i>
Write a letter as the author to a movie producer to interest them in making a movie about your book.	Draw three sketches of three different scenes in your book. They should include details of the characters and setting.	Create an online Jeopardy game for your book.	Find three songs that are related to something in your book. Write a page explaining how the songs are related to the book.
Write a different ending for your book.	Create a diorama or sculpture that represents something from your book. Include a museum placard with a title and description of what the piece represents.	Create a Google Presentation about an informative topic in your book. See your teacher for details.	Retell the story of your book in a minute. Make sure to include the main events in your story.
Write a plot for the sequel . Use the elements of fiction to guide your plot.	Draw a character tree for a character in your book. You will include at least three specific details about five character traits of your choice.	Create a movie trailer for your book. See your teacher for details.	Give a sales talk as if you were trying to convince people to buy the book.
Write a book review like you would find in the newspaper.	Rewrite the story of your book for younger children in picture book form.	Create a podcast about your book. See your teacher for details.	Found Poem -Select a chapter from the novel you have just read that you consider powerful or interesting. Then select words, lines, and phrases that you think project strong images and show the impact the chapter makes. Arrange this material into a poem, and perform it.
